



AB 392 doesn't target bad cops

It puts a target on **every** cop.

Anti-cop bills like AB 392 drive a deeper wedge between the police and vulnerable communities where they're needed most.

AB 392 assumes all cops are "trigger happy" and threatens them with criminal prosecution whenever use-of-force decisions are made.

The result — hesitation when seconds matter, slower response in emergencies, a greater chance of injury or death for officers and the people they protect.

Instead of turning cops into criminals, better training is a better way to build trust and save lives.
