### **In life and death encounters, cops have seconds to decide.**

But AB 392 (Weber) would force officers to second-guess their decisions, slowing their emergency response when seconds matter — endangering their lives and the lives of the people they protect.

Instead of improving officer training and bringing clarity to use-of-force policies, AB 392:

- **Turns cops into criminals** by putting them at risk of criminal prosecution for split-second decisions made in life-threatening situations
- **Adds new confusion to current use-of-force policies** with vague, unclear and imprecise language
- **Devalues officer lives** by putting their right to defend themselves below the self-defense rights of citizens
