COPS 'NEED TO BE KILLED': CALIFORNIA PROFESSOR'S OLD COMMENTS RESURFACE AFTER OFFICER FATALLY SHOT

Former comments from a University of California, Davis professor endorsing violence against police have resurfaced after the fatal shooting of a Davis officer.

Anti-cop bills like AB 392 fuel the hate.

AB 392 says “yeah, police are the bad guys and need to be punished” — driving a deeper wedge between the police and vulnerable communities, risking lives by slowing response time, feeding old suspicions instead of building trust.

AB 392 turns cops into criminals by threatening them with prison time for split-second decisions made when seconds count, causing them to hesitate in emergencies, endangering their lives and the lives of those they protect.
