



SB 136 MAKES IT EASIER FOR ABUSERS TO ABUSE

Under the guise of criminal justice reform, Senate Bill 136 actually makes it easier for repeat offenders to keep abusing their victims.

SB 136 removes judicial discretion, essentially reducing the sentences of repeat offenders convicted of:

- Felony Child Abuse
- Felony Domestic Violence
- Felony Stalking
- Felony Elder Abuse
- A myriad of Felony Firearm Possession crimes

According to the National Center for Health Research, domestic violence often follows a repeated cycle. Yet this bill's author boasts that it will "keep families together" — a terrifying prospect for the children and spouses who the repeat abusers will be coming home to.

SB 136 is not reform — it's just another way for abusers to get the upper hand over their victims.
